






































The earth is warming much faster than expected and we are on track to reaching 3°C rather than stay below 2°C as per the Paris Agreement



### The SMART Way 5 Transformational Policies that Work



- 1. Accelerated renewable energy growth:
  - halving emissions every decade from 2030 on
- 2. Accelerated productivity in food chains:
  - +1% p.a. better productivity
- 3. New development models in developing countries:
  - copying features of S-Korea, Chinese, Ethiopian successes
- 4. Active inequality reduction:
  - ensuring 10% richest < 40% of income
- Investment in education, gender equality, family planning, and health is stabilizing the world population
  - improving well-being with reduced ecological footprint
